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Job Responsibilities:

Conduct eye exams using ophthalmic equipment and general diagnostic interpretation.

Diagnose and treat ocular disease.

Prescribe, fit, and adjust eyeglasses, contact lenses, and other vision aids.

Recommend appropriate patient follow-up and care options.

Answer questions and provide advice to patients regarding vision and optical issues.

Deliver outstanding patients service through all patient interactions.

Direct staff and assist in the development of the overall practice.

- Provide pre- and postoperative care to patients undergoing eye surgery—for example, examining a patient's eyes the day after surgery.
- Evaluate patients for the presence of other diseases and conditions, such as diabetes or hypertension, and refer patients to other healthcare providers as needed.

Promote eye health by counseling patients.

Submit a case study of a patient who has benefited from the services of the project on monthly basis, and it is essential to include both the pre and post-eye examination images.
