

**INSTRUCTIONS TO APPLY FOR FELLOWSHIP & MEMBERSHIP
RESIDENCY TRAINING PROGRAMS
(SESSION COMMENCING FROM JULY 2026)**

Instructions for Filling the Application Form

Please read carefully before completing the form:

1. Fill out the application form in your own handwriting. Incomplete forms will not be accepted.
2. Use **capital letters** and **black ink** only.
3. All photocopies must be attested by an officer of **BPS-18 or above**.
4. Submit a **Bank Draft of Rs. 5,000/-** (non-refundable) in favor of *Sindh Institute of Ophthalmology & Visual Sciences (SIOVS), Hyderabad*.
5. Completed application forms with required documents must be submitted in the Academic Block of the Institute on or before **10th June 2026**

Important Notes

1. Eligible candidates must appear for the Pre-Entry Written Test at SIOVS Hyderabad on **16th June 2026 at 10:00 AM**. No individual communication will be issued.
2. The Institute reserves the right to modify the schedule due to unforeseen circumstances.
3. Candidates who are awaiting FCPS-I results may submit their applications and appear in the Pre-Entry Test at their own risk. However, they must present a valid passing result prior to the interview, failing which they will not be considered for final selection.
4. Selection is subject to the availability of training slots.
5. Applicants currently serving in government departments must submit a valid **Departmental No Objection Certificate (NOC)** along with their application. The NOC must clearly state that, in the event of final selection, the candidate will be permitted to join the training program without administrative hindrance.
6. Selected government employees must submit a **Departmental Study Leave or Permission Notification** within one week of their provisional selection. Failure to comply may result in cancellation of the admission offer.
7. All applicants applying as **Private Candidates** must submit an Affidavit on Court Paper worth Rs. 200/-, duly attested by a Notary Public or Oath Commissioner, affirming that they are not appointed to or currently serving in any government position. This affidavit is a mandatory requirement and must be submitted along with the application form.

MCPS OPHTHALMOLOGY RESIDENCY TRAINING PROGRAM

(DURATION: 02 YEARS)

Eligibility Criteria

- MBBS Degree from PMDC recognized institution.
- Minimum CGPA 3.00
- Valid Registration with Pakistan Medical & Dental Council.
- Completed one year house job in PMDC recognized institution.
- Foreign Graduates will have to produce equivalence of their degree.

Required Documents

- Six passport size photographs with white background.
- MBBS degree from PMDC recognized institution.
- MBBS consolidated marks certificate/transcript.
- Valid PMDC Registration Certificate.
- House Job Certificates (One Year)
- Domicile Certificate
- Character certificate
- Medical Fitness Certificate
- Valid Computerized National Identity Card (CNIC)

- Applicants currently serving in government departments must submit a valid Departmental No Objection Certificate (NOC) along with their application. The NOC must clearly state that, in the event of final selection, the candidate will be permitted to join the training program without administrative hindrance.

- All applicants applying as Private Candidates must submit an Affidavit on Court Paper worth Rs. 200/-, duly attested by a Notary Public or Oath Commissioner, affirming that they are not appointed to or currently serving in any government position. This affidavit is a mandatory requirement and must be submitted along with the application form.

FCPS-II Ophthalmology Residency Training Program (Duration: 04 Years)

Eligibility Criteria

- MBBS Degree from PMDC recognized institution.
- Valid Registration with Pakistan Medical & Dental Council.
- Completed one year house job in PMDC recognized institution.
- Candidates who have passed the FCPS-I in Ophthalmology are eligible to apply for the FCPS-II ophthalmology residency program within a three-year period.
- Foreign Graduates will have to produce equivalence of their degree.

- MBBS degree from PMDC recognized institution.
- MBBS consolidated marks certificate/transcript.
- Valid FCPS-I in Ophthalmology Pass certificate / Congratulation Letter.
- Valid PMDC Registration Certificate.
- House Job Certificates (One Year)
- Domicile Certificate
- Character Certificate
- Medical Fitness Certificate
- Valid Computerized National Identity Card (CNIC)

- Candidates who have passed the FCPS-II in Ophthalmology is eligible to apply.
- Foreign Graduates will have to produce equivalence of their degree.

- MBBS degree from PMDC recognized institution.
- Valid FCPS-II in Ophthalmology Pass certificate / Congratulation Letter.
- Valid PMDC Registration Certificate.
- The Qualification of FCPS-II Ophthalmology must be registered with Pakistan Medical & Dental Council.
- House Job Certificates (One Year)
- Domicile Certificate
- Character Certificate
- Medical Fitness Certificate
- Valid Computerized National Identity Card (CNIC)

- Applicants currently serving **in government departments** must submit a valid Departmental No Objection Certificate (NOC) along with their application. The NOC must clearly state that, in the event of final selection, the candidate will be permitted to join the training program without administrative hindrance.
